Sun Trolley Begins First 7-Day Route, Extends to Flagler Village

Starting Monday, May 14, 2007, the Sun Trolley system will operate its first 7-day route. The current Downtown Courthouse Loop which operates 7:30a-6:00p, Monday thru Friday, has been extended to cover the Fort Lauderdale long weekend, beginning Thursday evening thru Sunday night. The new extended service, called the North-South Downtown Circulator, and the Downtown Courthouse Loop also have been expanded north along Andrews to provide trolley transit service to the Flagler Village area.

Both the **“New” North–South Downtown Circulator**, and the expanded Downtown Courthouse Loop, provide access to and from the Broward County Downtown Government Center, Fort Lauderdale City Hall, Broward County Courthouse, Broward County Schools Headquarters, and Flagler Village. The extended weekend **North-South Downtown Circulator** operates 6:00p to 11:00p on Thursdays, 6:00p to 11:30p on Fridays, 10:00a to 11:30p on Saturdays, and 10:00a to 11:00p on Sundays. Fares for these routes are \$.50 per boarding.

“The Sun Trolley route additions will connect our Flagler Village community with downtown employment centers, the library, businesses, shopping, and entertainment. Our residents will enjoy all the benefits from this type of service. In addition to saving costs associated with fuel and parking expenses, the outcome will also lessen traffic congestion and improve the overall air quality of our city,” says City of Fort Lauderdale Commissioner Charlotte Rodstrom.

The **“New” North-South Downtown Circulator** also connects to the Las Olas/Beaches long weekend route, enabling residents in the Flagler Village area to travel to the Las Olas area and the Fort Lauderdale beach via transit. The **“New” North-South Downtown Circulator** runs every 16 minutes and can be “waved down,” “hailed” or “flagged down” anywhere along its route.

Sun Trolley transit services are provided through a joint partnership with the City of Fort Lauderdale, Broward County Transit, the Downtown Development Authority, and the Metropolitan Planning Organization.
